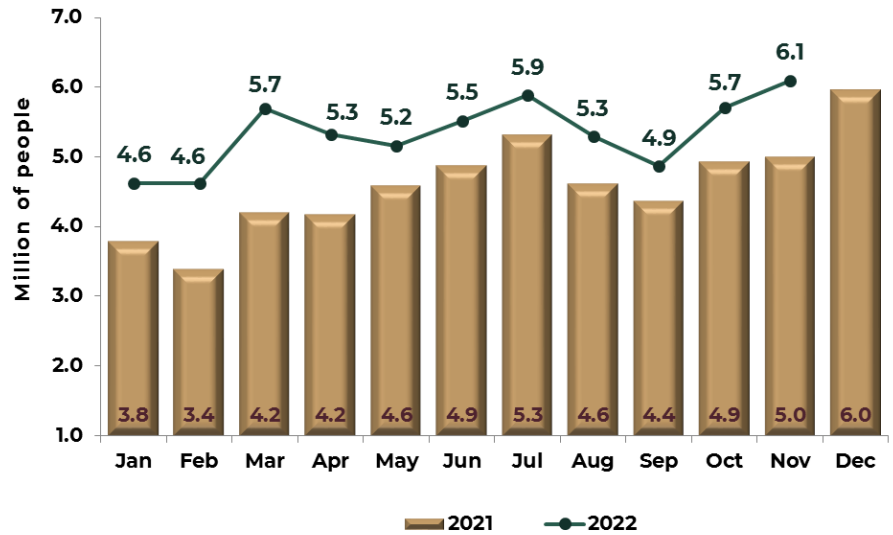




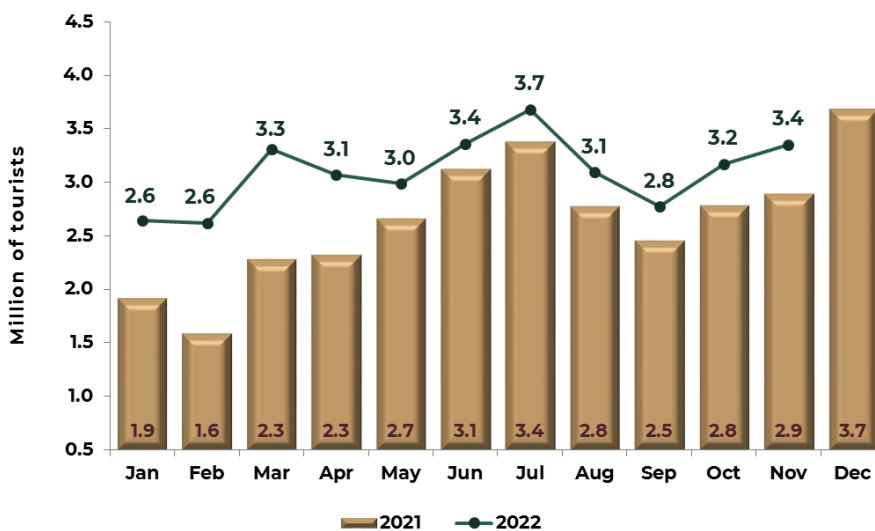

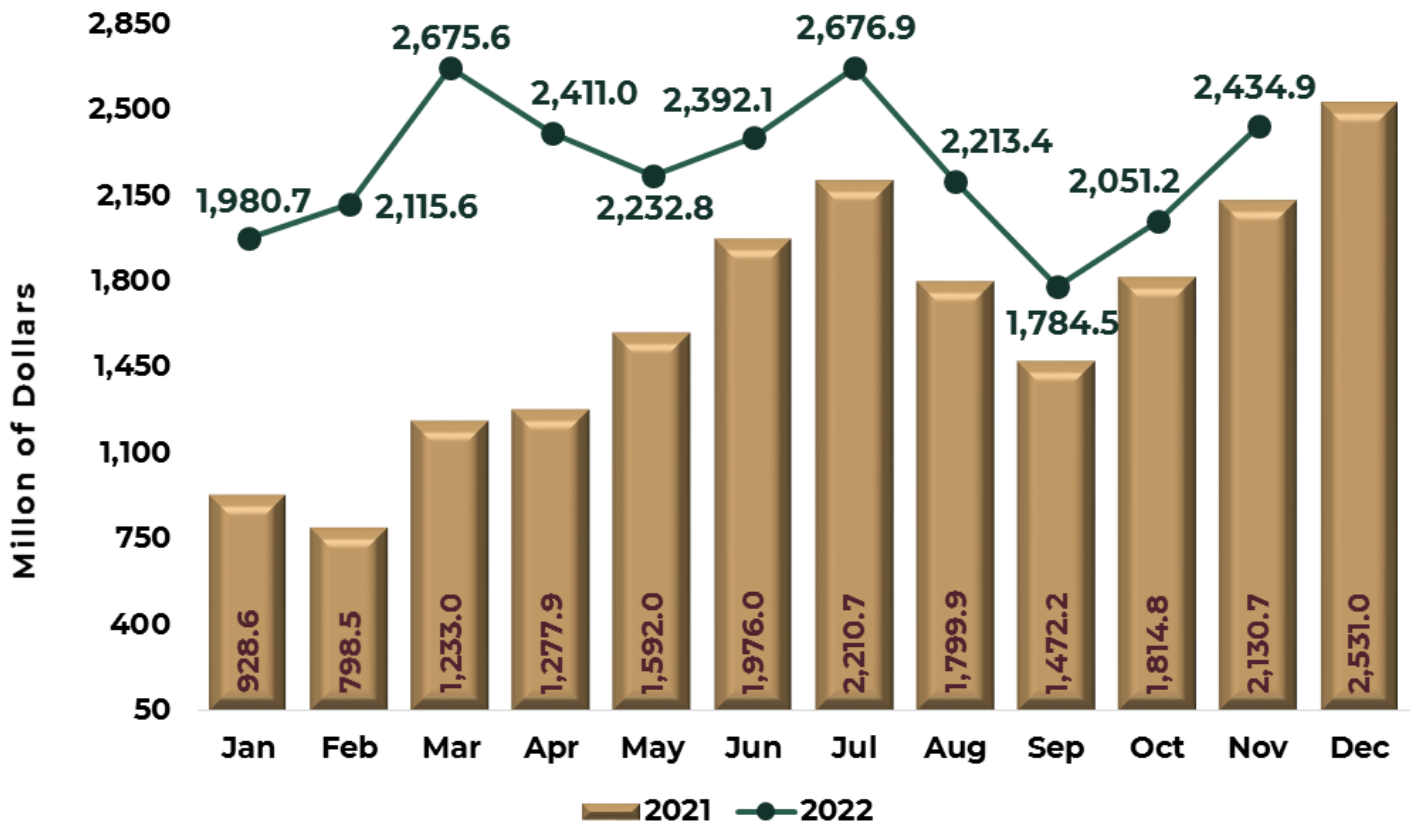

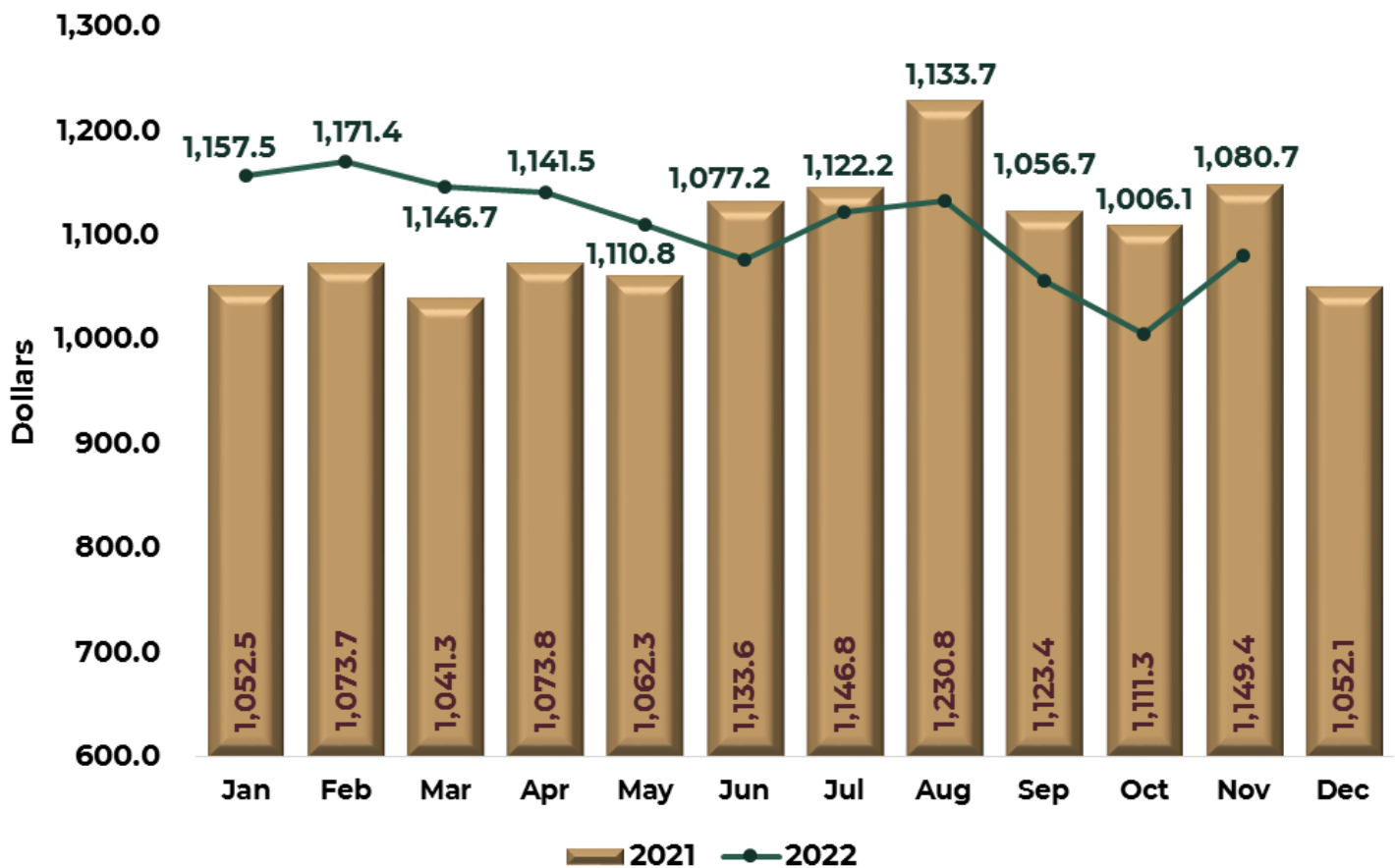

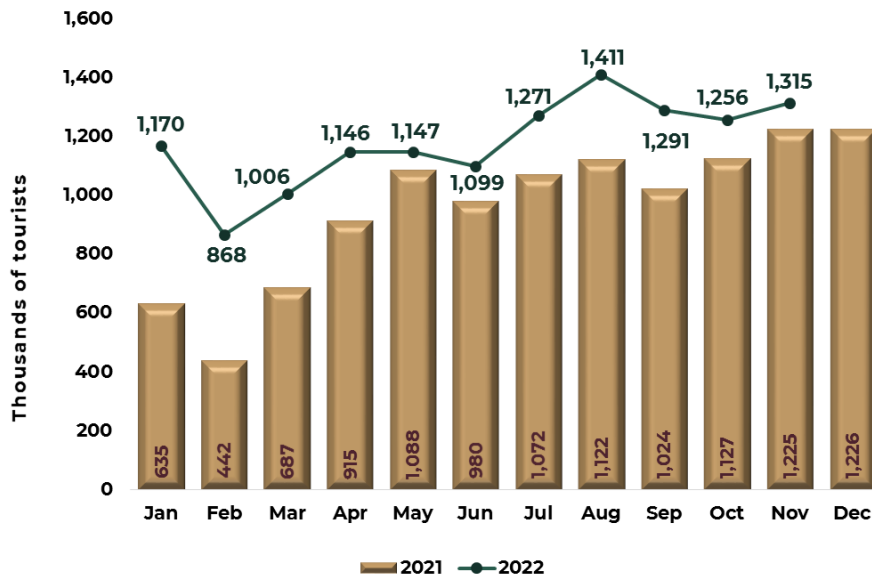

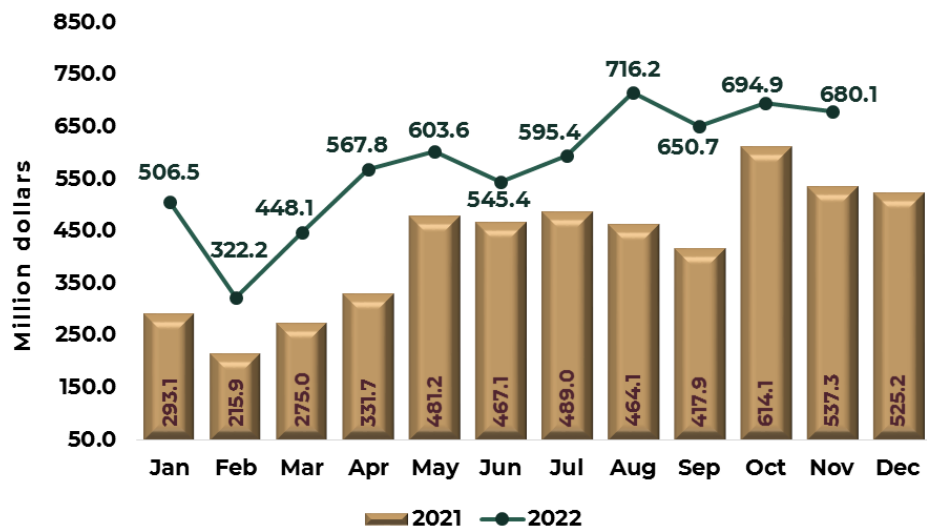

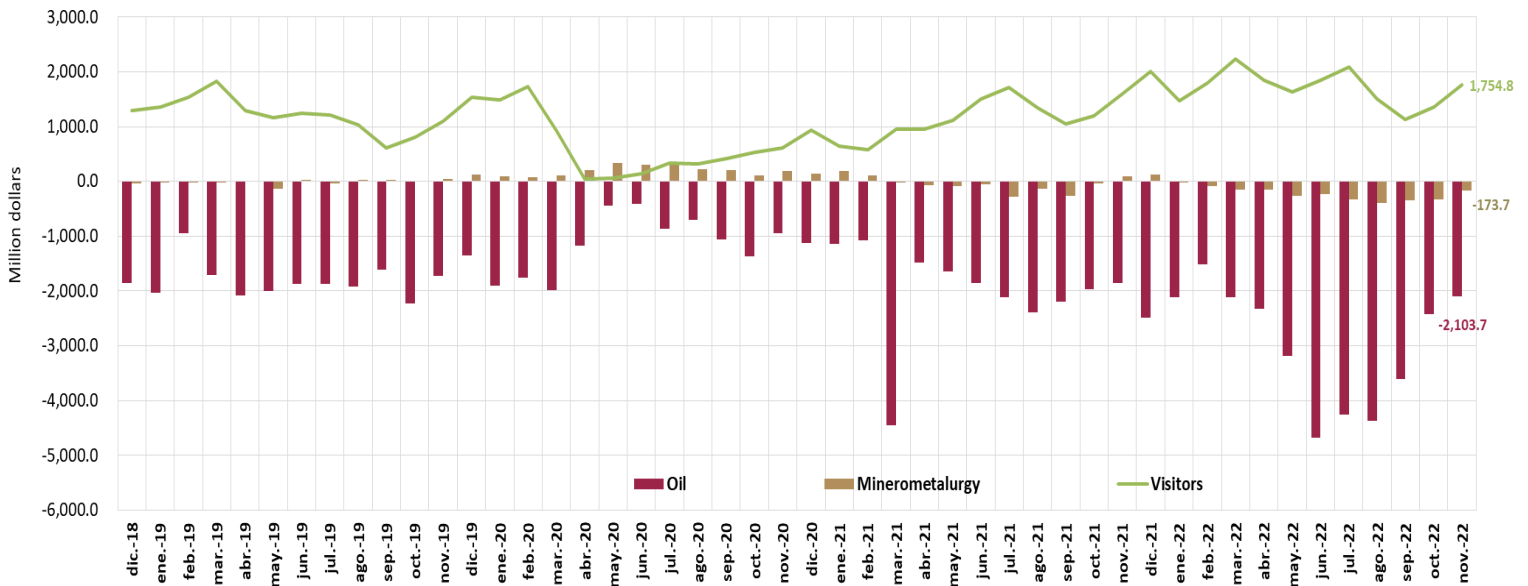

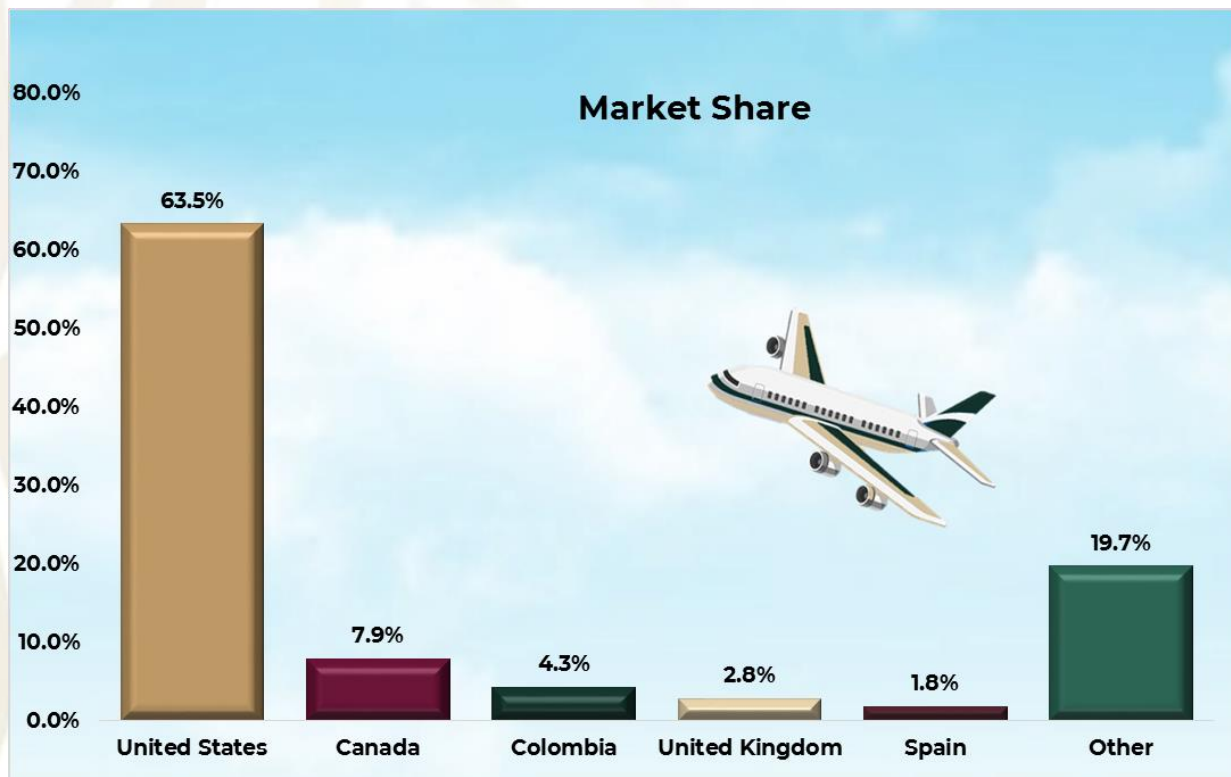

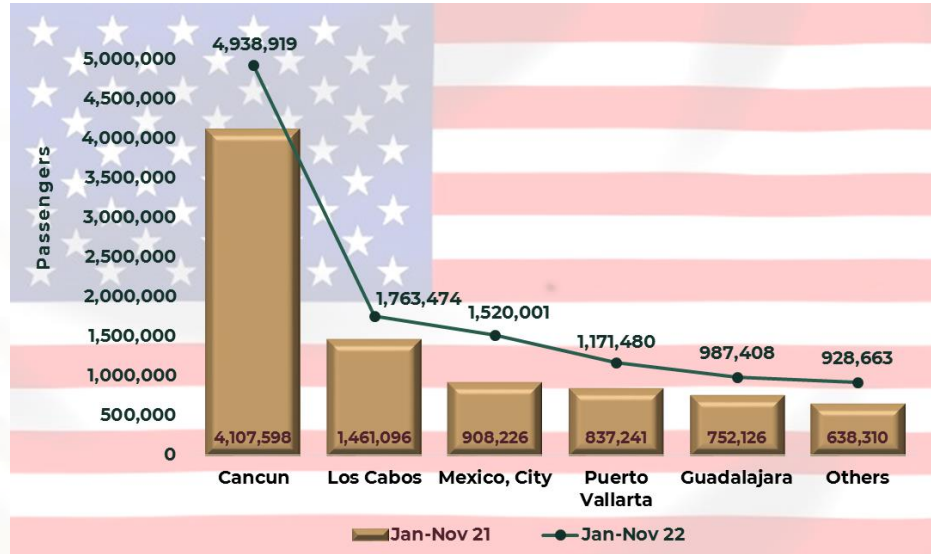

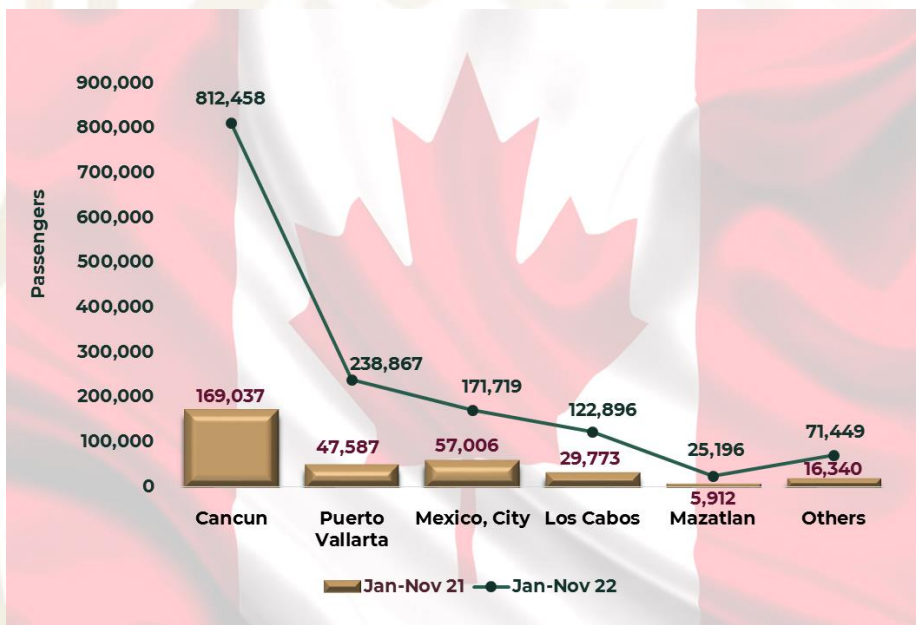

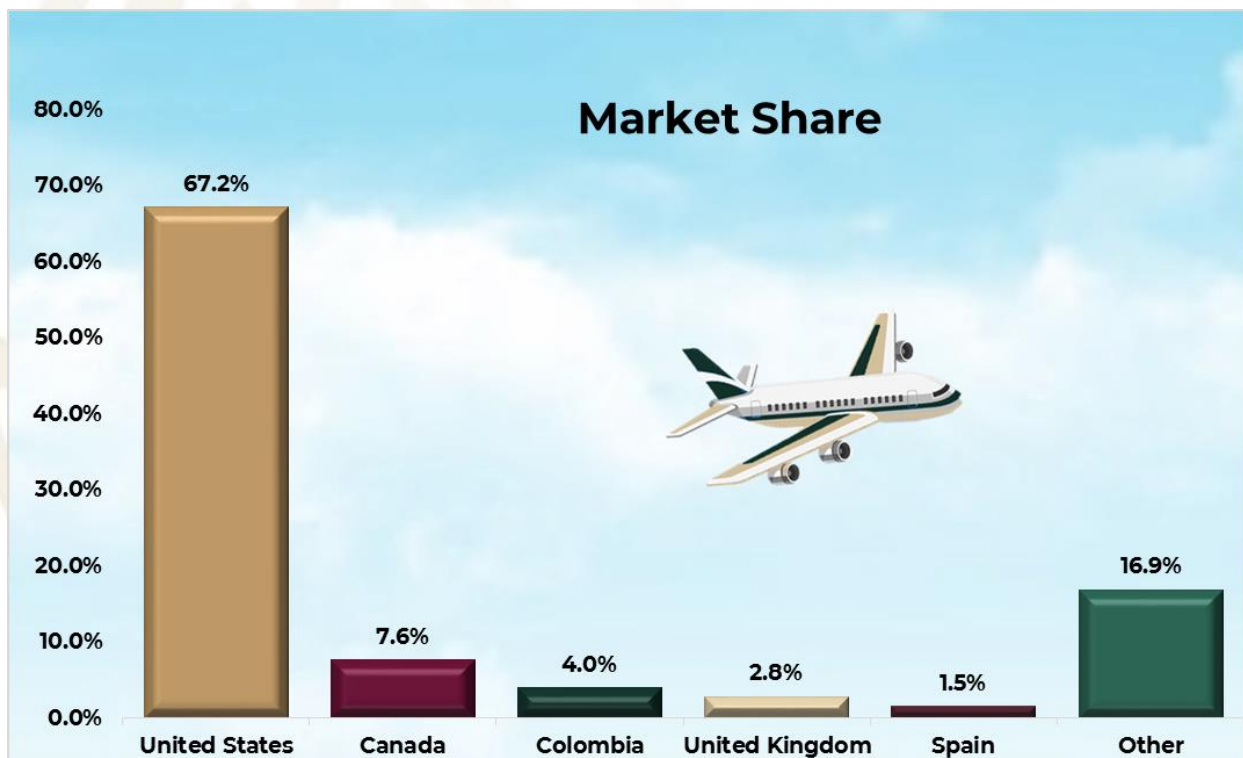

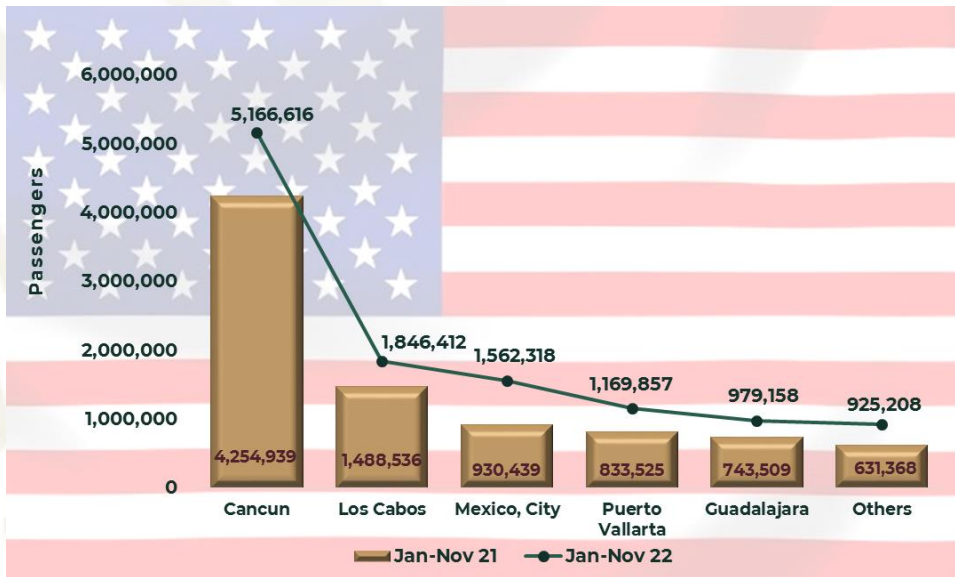

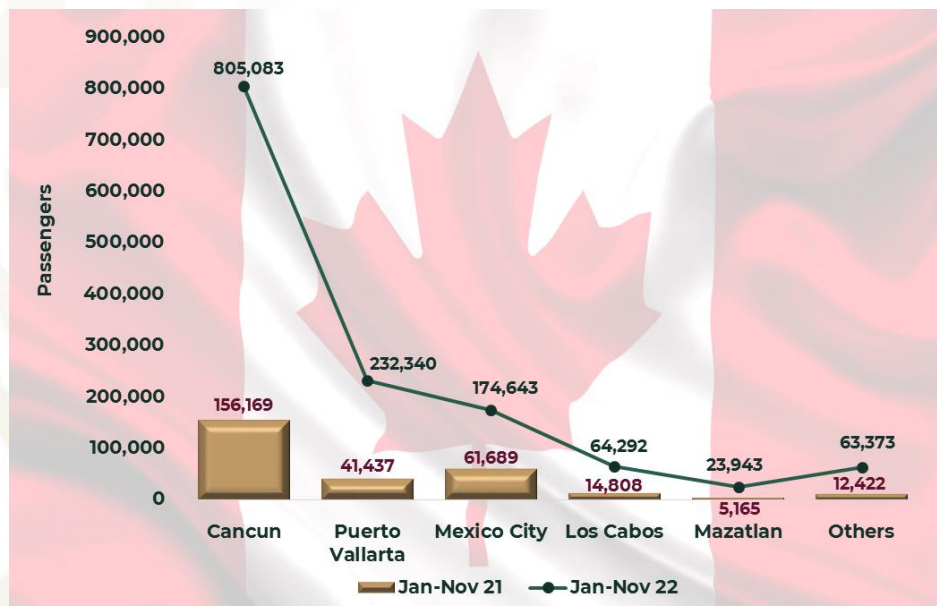

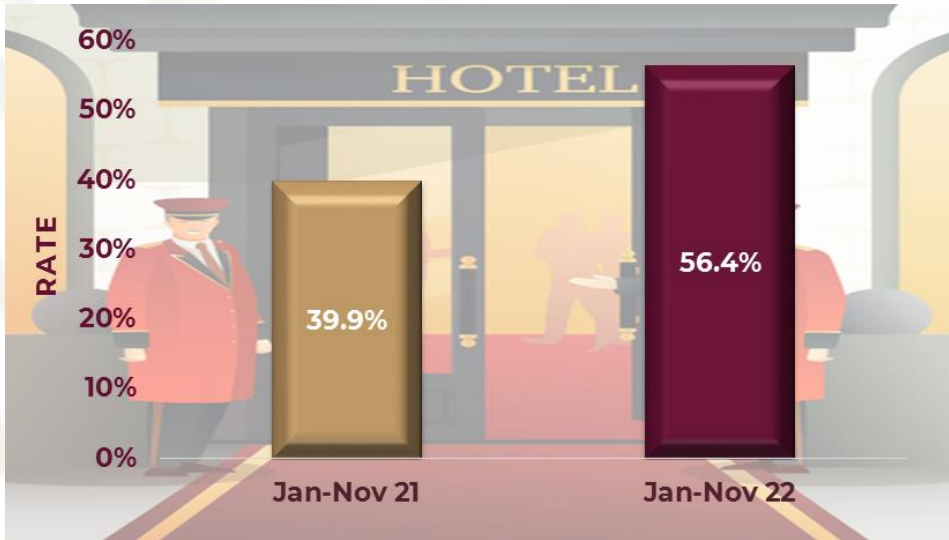

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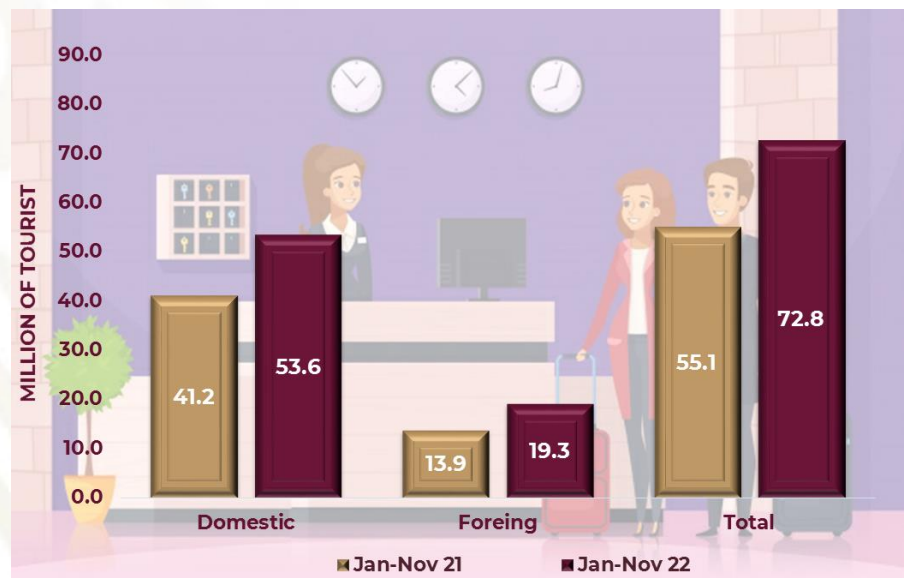
## OCCUPANCY RATE

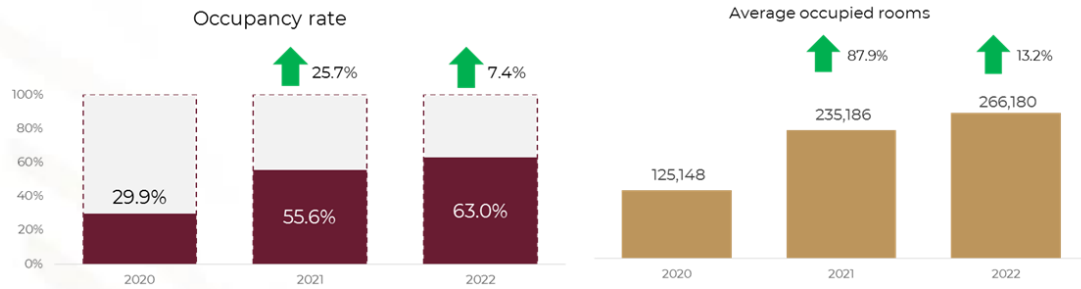

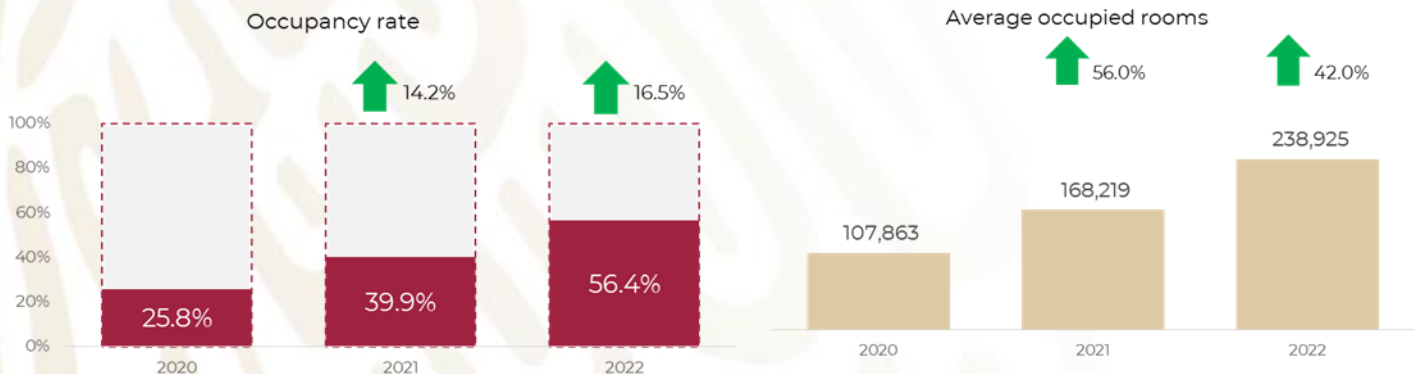

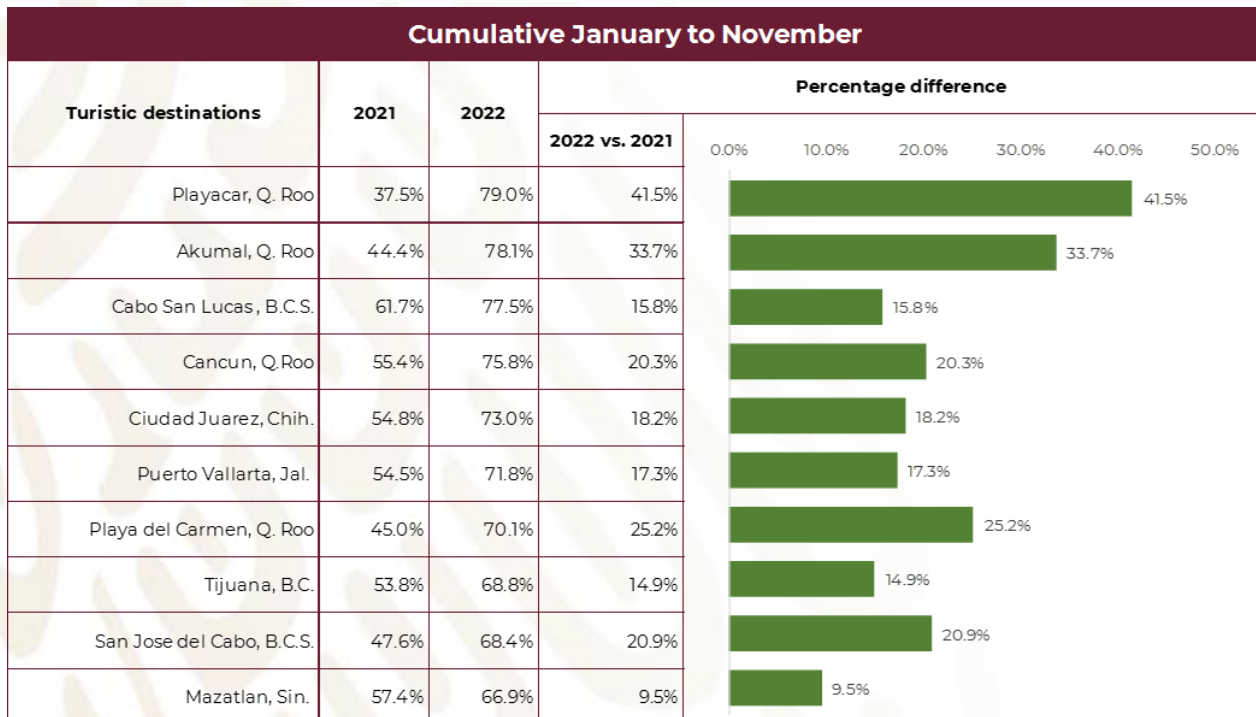
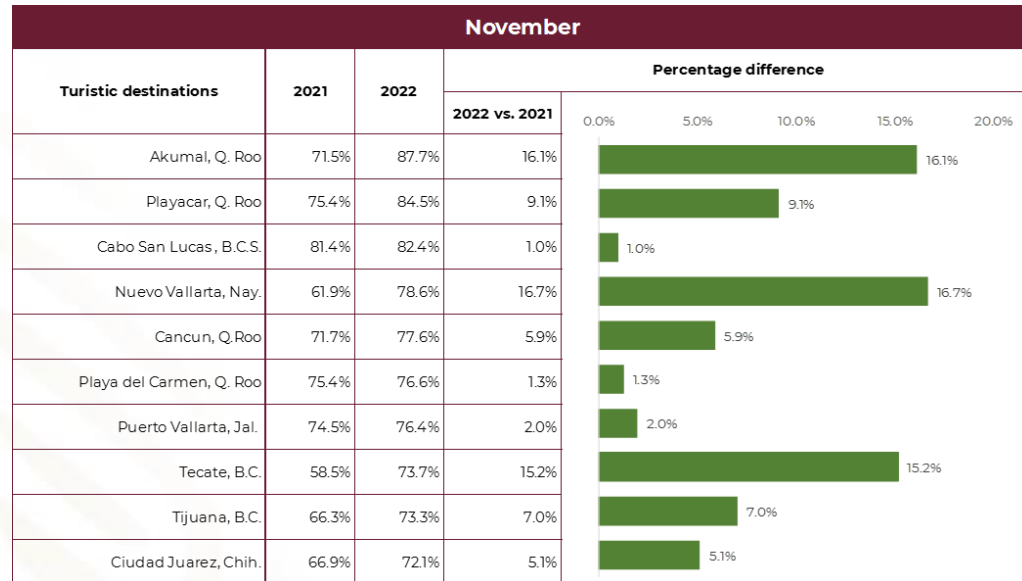

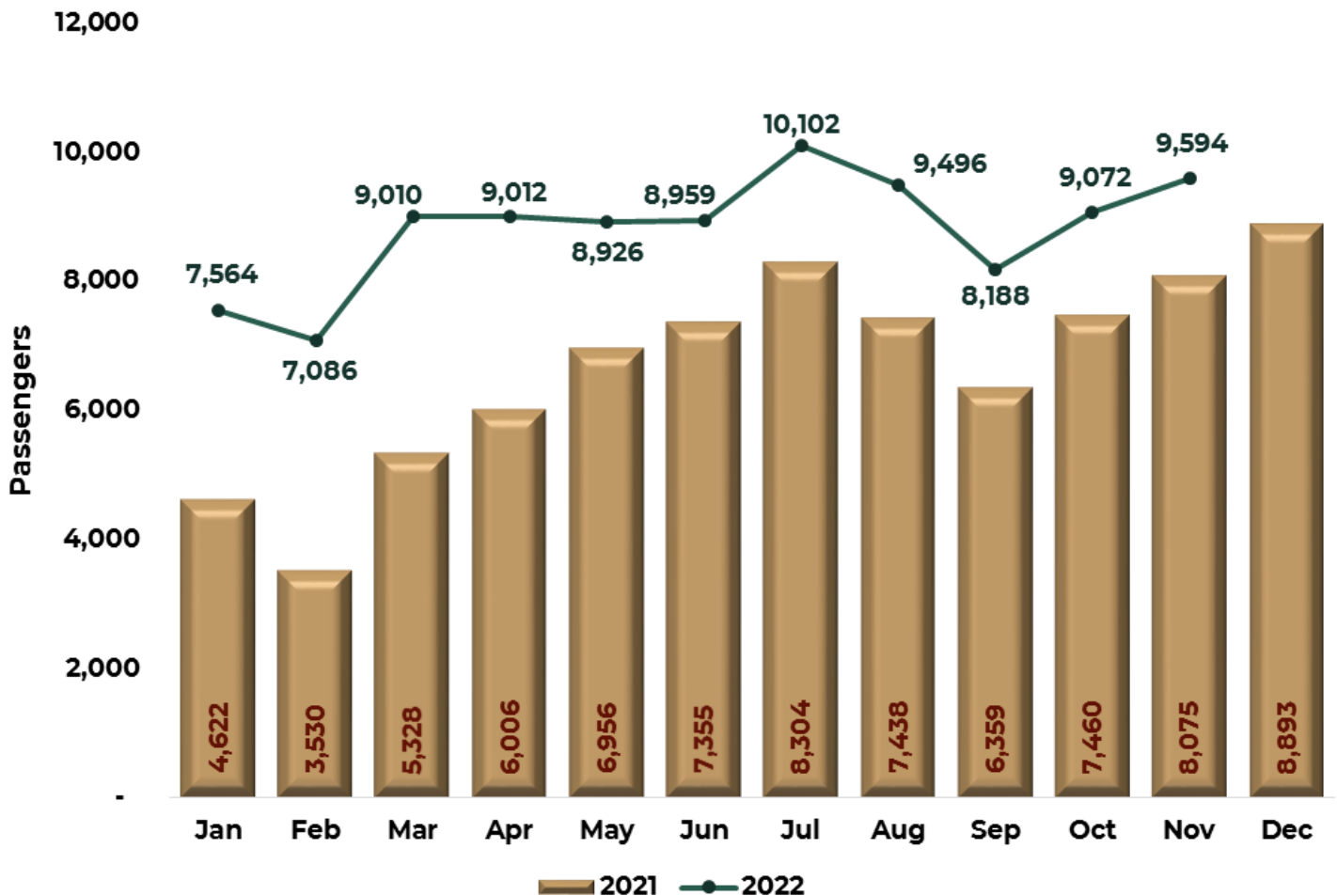

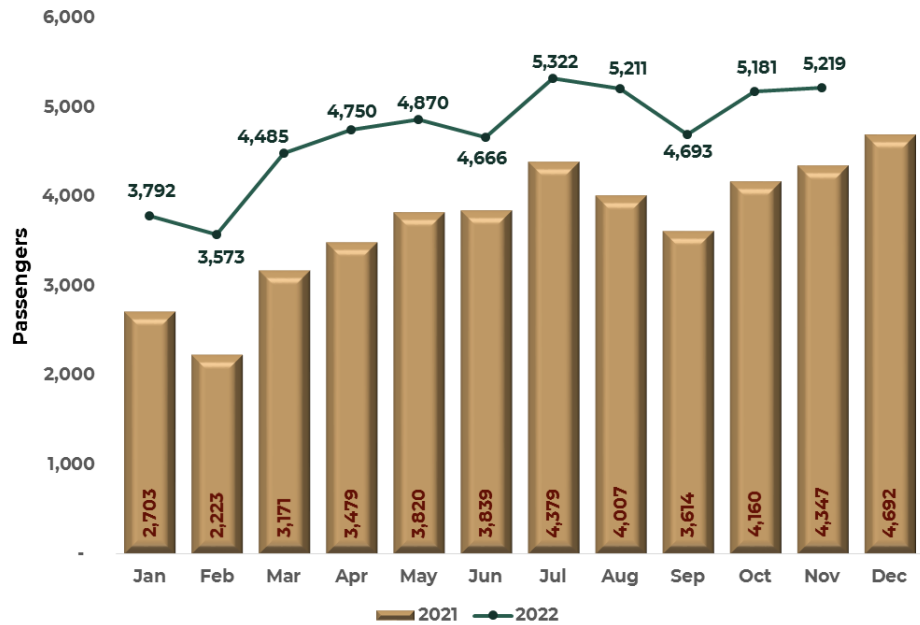




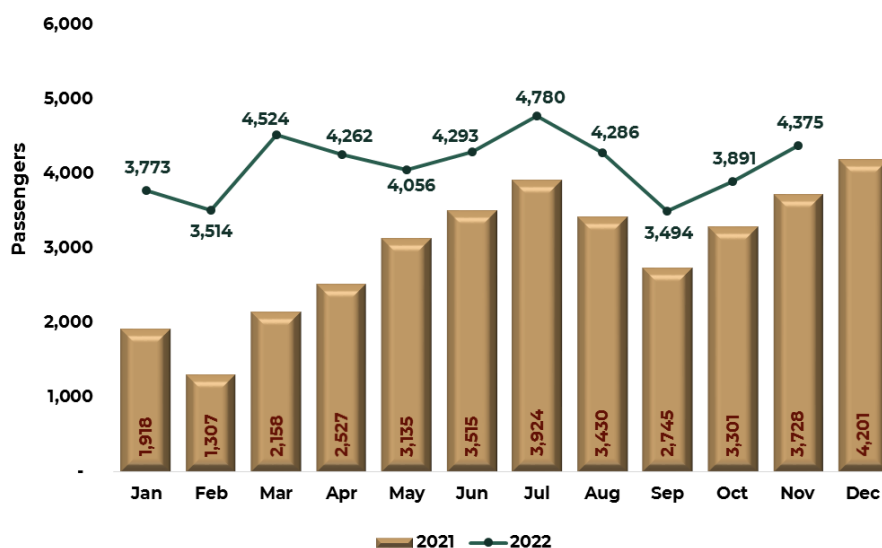

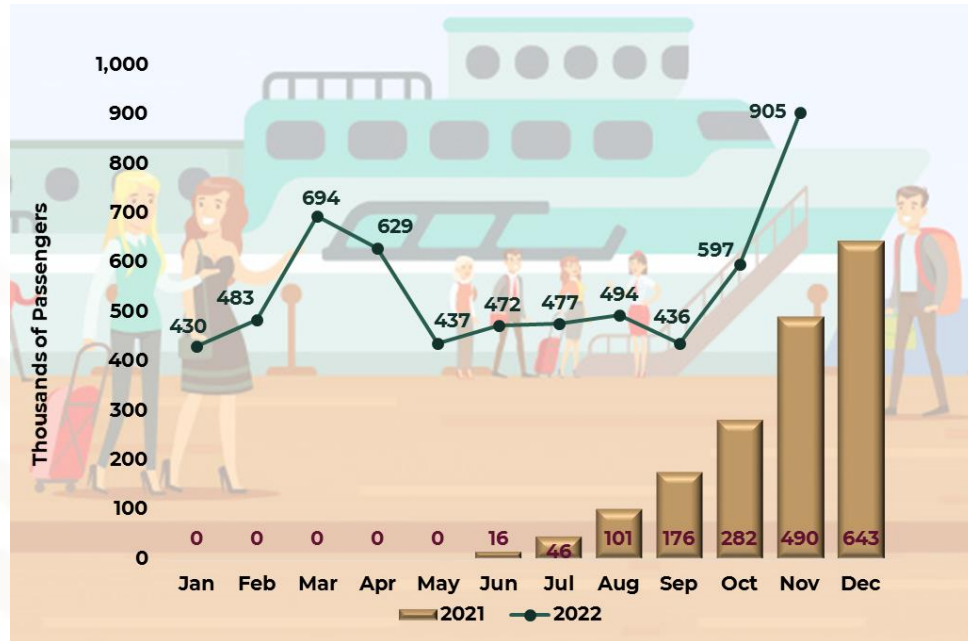




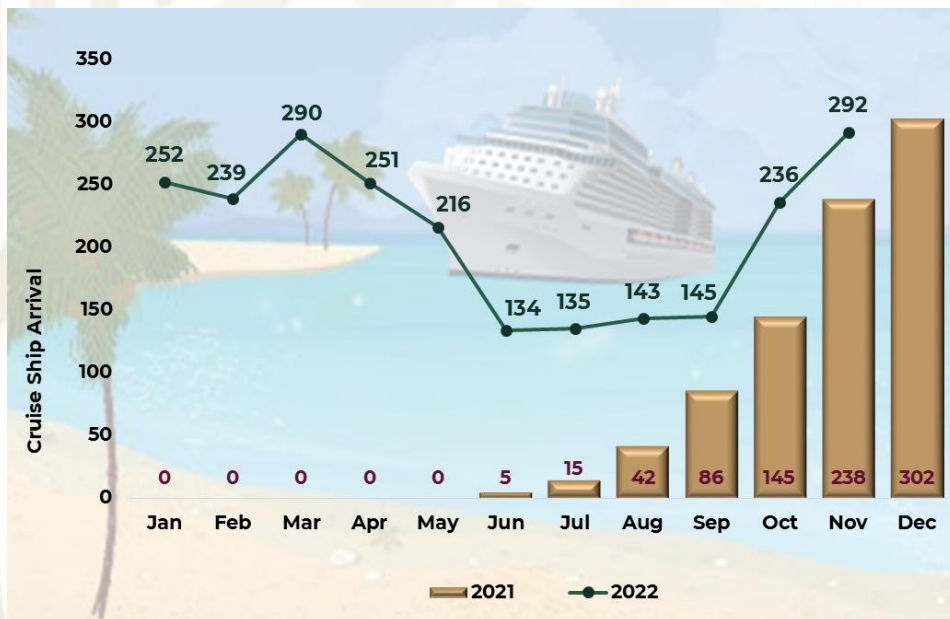

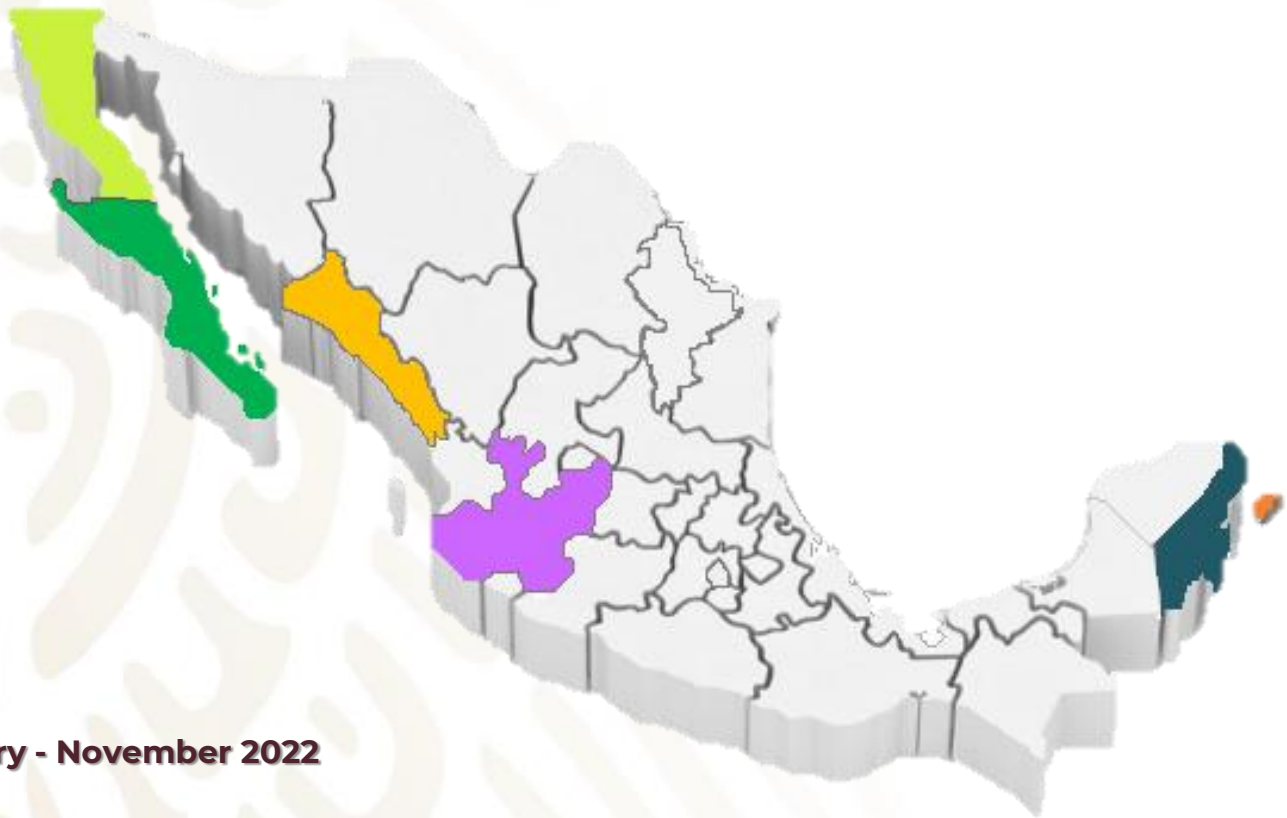

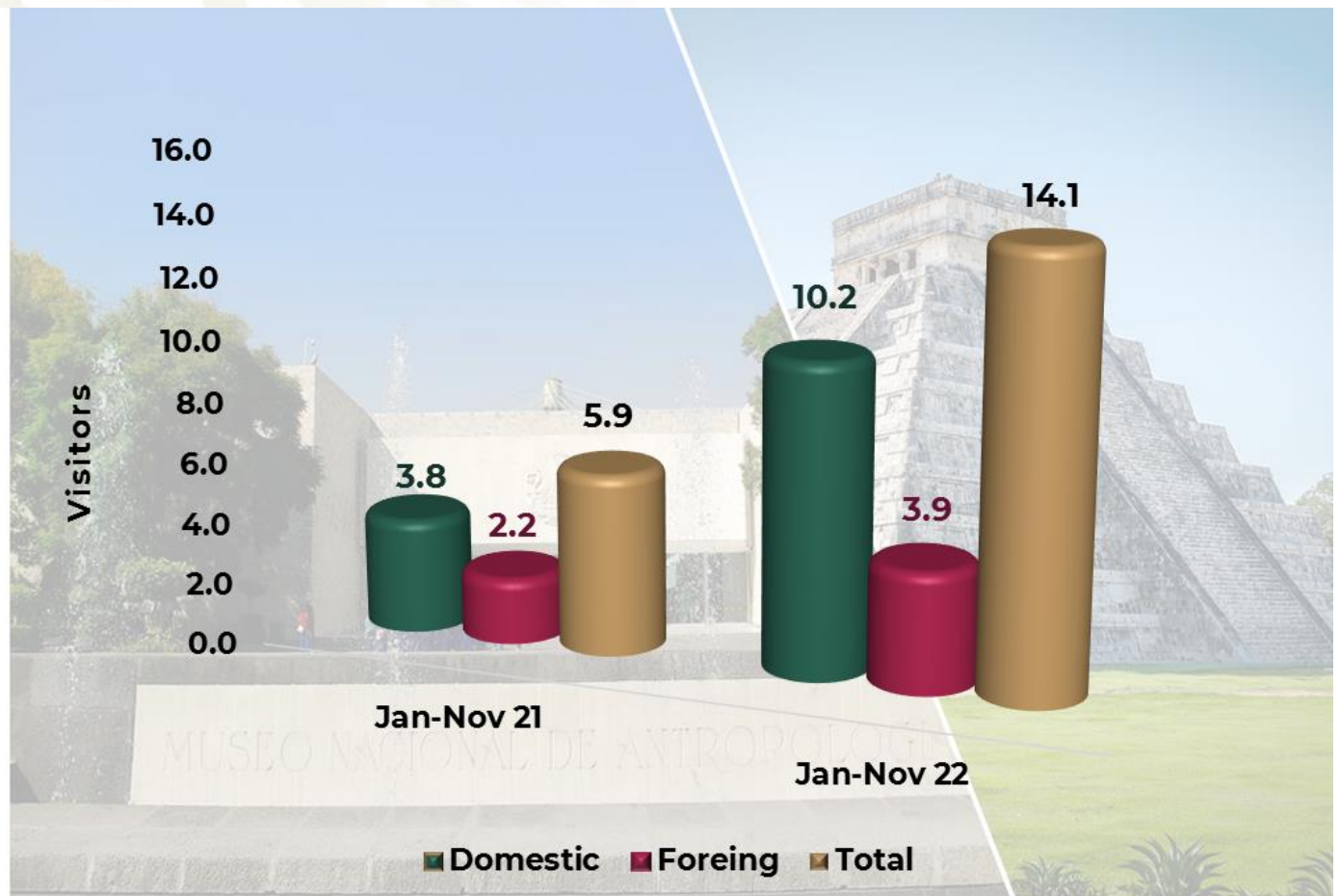




## VISITORS TO MUSEUMS AND ARCHEOLOGICAL SITES

**Chart 24.** During the period January-November of 2022, the National Institute of Anthropology and History reported the arrival of **14 million 87 thousand visitors** to museums and archaeological sites, that is, 8 million 146 thousand visitors more than reported in the same period of 2021, which represented an increase of **137.1%**. # OTHERS INDICATORS AND ANALYSIS OF INTERNATIONAL TOURISM

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## ECONOMIC CONTEXT (Ministry of Finance)

### National

Timely information on economic activity in Mexico in the third quarter of 2022 indicates that the levels prior to the pandemic were reached by COVID-19, so that this time the growth is largely explained by the boost of the services sector, although those sectors most affected by social alienation show a slower recovery.

By the fourth quarter of 2022, economic activity is expected to continue to recover, albeit at a slower pace than observed in previous quarters, given an adverse international context.

In terms of external demand, exports have shown an upward trend, in particular manufacturing exports, which continue to boost the dynamism of aggregate demand.

### International

World economic activity recovered in the third quarter of 2022, a fact that is explained by the recovery of the US economy and the reopening of activities in China, although there are signs of effects on international trade.

By 2023, global growth prospects continue to deteriorate, owing in part to more restrictive financial conditions and geopolitical tensions. Among the main risks to the world economy are those associated with the pandemic and variants of COVID-19, the spread of inflationary pressures and tensions arising from the Russia-Ukraine conflict.

The likelihood of a recession in the global economy in 2023 remains high, although it is expected to be shallow and short-lived. A significant number of central banks have raised their reference rates, although some are expected to begin to moderate the scale of their increases. In fact, the implicit interest rate trajectory for the next two years in several of the economies has been adjusted downwards.
