


































By components, **services** increased by **0.1%** in real terms and **goods**, had an increase of **0.6%** over what was recorded in the fourth quarter 2022.

ECONOMIC CONTEXT (Ministry of Finance)

National

As for Mexico's economic activity, during the second quarter of 2023, its performance continued strong, supported mainly by the strength of its domestic demand and, to a lesser extent, by a greater contribution of manufacturing exports. On the first point, they highlighted the high levels of job creation and the increase in wages, factors that supported the growth of private consumption and the demand for imports. In addition, higher volumes of gross fixed investment were observed in the context of high demand for machinery and equipment, non-residential investment in industrial spaces and the progress of the Federal Government's infrastructure projects.

With information from the Global Indicator of Economic Activity (IGAE), between April and May, growth of 0.8% was higher than the previous three bimonthly and with respect to the end of 2022 accumulated a growth of 1.5%, with figures adjusted for seasonality. This result not only meant that the IGAE accumulated 10 bimonthly consecutive increases, but also that the growth of economic activity by 2023 remained in line with what was foreseen in the 2023 Economic Package. In the interior, there was a slight increase in primary activities as a result of better weather conditions, while secondary activities grew, supported mainly by the manufacturing and construction sectors, while the tertiary sector was boosted by the trade and transport, leisure, cultural and sports sectors.

In the external sector, during the two months of April and May, Mexican exports registered an increase of 0.4% over the previous two months and accumulated a growth of 3.0% in the year, with figures adjusted for seasonality.

International

As for Mexico's economic activity, during the second quarter of 2023, its performance During the second quarter of the year, global economic activity maintained a positive pace of growth, despite continued increases in monetary policy rates in emerging and advanced economies, as well as the tightening of credit standards and geopolitical conflicts. This dynamism came mainly from the strength of the services sectors and the domestic demand of these economies, supported by a good performance of labour markets, mainly in advanced economies. In addition, lower supply restrictions due to greater standardization of supply chains and lower costs of energy and industrial materials allowed the global supply of products to be increased.

While this contributed to reducing price pressures relative to the previous quarter and keeping inflation expectations anchored, overall inflation rates remained above the target level of most of the world's central banks. Factors such as the persistence of a labor demand relatively higher than the labor supply and the persistence in the inflation of services and food affected the prices of the economies and validated the need to maintain, or even adjust upwards, the restrictive monetary stance in the major central banks.

Given this scenario, among the largest economies mixed signals were observed around their economic performance during the second quarter. The gross domestic product (GDP) of the United States (USA) registered a quarterly growth of 0.6% real, supported by private consumption in services, in line with greater job creation. Meanwhile, investment in the residential and non-residential sectors made a slight positive contribution, despite the persistence of high long-term interest rates.
